## What's happening this half term

We have lots of exciting things lined up for this half term, starting with Pancake day this coming Tuesday, the children will be making their own pancakes and choosing toppings.

This coming Thursday 6th March is World Book Day. The children are encouraged to come in a costume linked to their favourite book or character. Lots of activities will be held throughout the week linked to story time, with staff dressing up to the children's favourite stories.

This will take us nicely up to Easter, we will be teaching the children about the celebration of Easter. The children will take part in an Easter egg hunt, along with lots of creative activities.
